QUESTION 3

A travel company has created a business process scorecard for its Rewards points redemption process, which has five steps.

The analyst edited the scorecard to use the "Geography" report group and the "Registration: Country-USA" dimension, as follows:



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However, upon saving the edited process scorecard, three of the steps are now missing. What must the analyst modify?

- B. Adjust the Grades to accommodate the report group.
- C. Create a new scorecard; do not edit an operational scorecard.

These events are weighted as indicated in the following image:

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What is the formula for the weighted count used to compute the % Activity for event Promo Code Issue and Abandon?

- A. Weighted Count = 69 * 0.25
- B. Weighted Count = 69 * 0.40
- C. Weighted Count = (69 * 0.40) / 0.25
- D. Weighted Count = 69 * (0.40 / 0.25)
