Correct Answer: B

If the network does not offer DHCP Option 150, the External Manager Address must be added manually. Note that any input in the field will override the setting provided by DHCP.

When the infrastructure is set to Cisco UCM; then CDP (Cisco Discovery Protocol) will be enabled and if CDP is successful, the endpoint will discover DHCP Option 150. In this case you can leave the External Manager Address field blank, as the DHCP server will provide the address automatically.

Backup and restore

All the system settings, which are available on the System configuration page, can be listed on-screen or stored as a text file (.tsh).

The .tsh file can be loaded back onto the system, thereby restoring the configuration.

Navigate to: **Maintenance** > Backup and Restore

Backing up or showing the current configuration

Click **Preview backup** to display the current settings on-screen.

Click **Take backup** to store the configuration as a text file.

Backup and Restore

Take backup of configuration

This will create a backup file of the configurations on the TelePresence system. The backup file can be used to restore the TelePresence system to a previous state.

Take backup Preview backup

Restore configuration from backup

Restore the TelePresence system from a backup file. Some configurations may require a reboot to take effect.

Restoring an earlier configuration

Click **Browse...** and find the file with the configuration you want to restore.

Click **Restore** to reconfigure the system as defined in the file.

Creating a system backup

1.

Go to Maintenance > Backup and restore.

2.

Optionally, enter an Encryption password with which to encrypt the backup file. If a password is specified, the same password will be required to restore the file.

3.

Click Create system backup file.

4.

After the backup file has been prepared, a pop-up window appears and prompts you to save the file (the exact wording depends on your browser). The default name is in the format: \_\_\_\_backup.tar.gz. (The file extension is normally .tar.gz.enc if an encryption password is specified. However, if you use Internet Explorer to create an encrypted backup file, the filename extension will be .tar.gz.gz by default. These different filename extensions have no operational impact; you can create and restore encrypted backup files using any supported browser.) The preparation of the system backup file may take several minutes. Do not navigate away from this page while the file is being prepared.

5.

Save the file to a designated location.

Log files are not included in the system backup file.

Restoring a previous backup



To restore the Expressway to a previous configuration of system data:

1.

Go to Maintenance > Backup and restore.

2.

In the Restore section, Browse to the backup file containing the configuration you want to restore.

3.

In the Decryption password field, enter the password that was used to create the backup file, or leave it blank if the backup file was created without a password.

4.

Click Upload system backup file.

5.

The Expressway checks the file and takes you to the Restore confirmation page.

If the backup file is not valid or an incorrect decryption password is entered, you will receive an error message at the top of the Backup and restore page.

You are shown the current software version and the number of calls.

6.

Read all the warning messages that appear before proceeding with the restore.

7.

Click Continue with system restore to continue with the restore process.

This will restart your system, so ensure that there are no active calls.

After the system restarts, you are taken to the Login page.

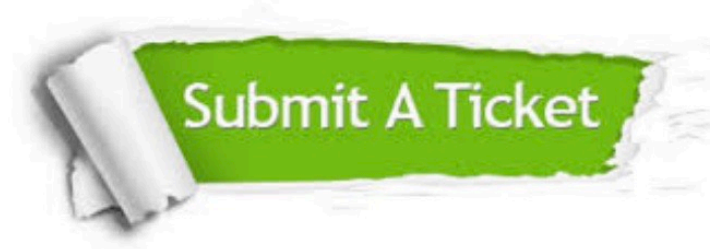
