Not A: There is a command line switch that can be used to schedule a task that will attempt to enroll the computer at a later time. This will ensure that the computer image is not enrolled before it has been deployed to the target computer. To

launch a delayed installation use the following command line argument to launch the installation:

Windows_Intune_Setup.exe /PrepareEnroll

Not C: You can use the Windows_Intune_Setup.exe /Extract command line argument on the Windows_Intune_Setup.exe file to extract both a 32 bit and 64 bit MSI package. Not D: You can use the Windows_Intune_Setup.exe/ Quiet

argument if you wish to suppress the Installation wizard and run it with no user interaction.
