Click the Exhibit button.



You are working in a composition that has the two layers shown in the exhibit. Layer 1 has a mask applied to it. You wish to animate the position of Layer 2 using the mask path coordinates from Layer 1. What is the most efficient process?

- A. select Layer 2, then use the Parent drop-down menu option next to the layer in the timeline to set its parent layer to Layer 1
- B. select Layer 1, open the Mask attributes in the timeline, select the Mask Path and go to Edit > Copy, then select Layer 2 and go to Edit > Paste
- C. select Layer 1, open the Mask attributes in the timeline, select the Mask Path and go to Edit > Copy, then select Layer 2, open the Transform attributes, select the Position property, and go to Edit > Paste
- D. open the Mask attributes for Layer 1 in the timeline, select Layer 2, open its Transform attributes, and set an expression for the Position by pressing Option/ALT and clicking the stopwatch, then drag the pick whip icon onto the Mask Path of Layer 1
