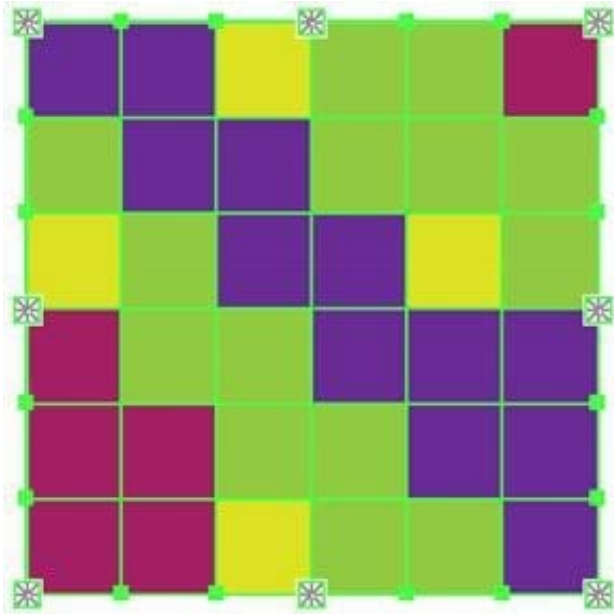

QUESTION 5
