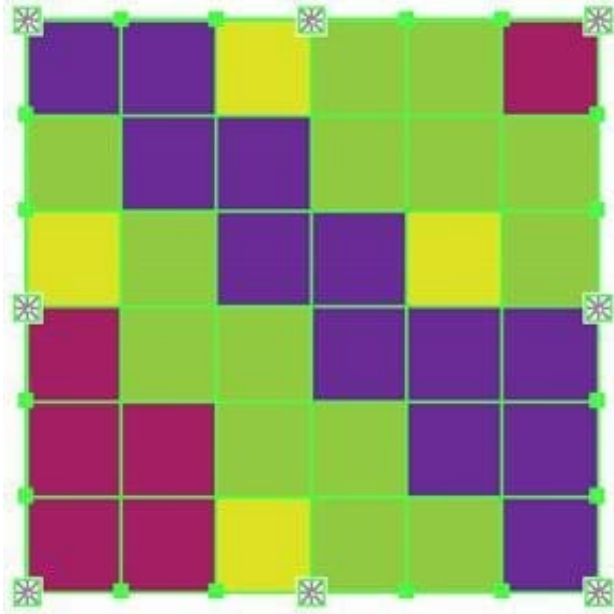

- C. Choose File > Document Color Mode > RGB.
