A line ID can have various attributes, such as cost element group, value category, posting indicator, and so on. By using expert mode in the valuation method for results analysis, you can use different line ID for different scenarios or requirements that are not covered by the standard valuation methods. In the accounting view of the material master, you can specify whether a material is relevant for valuated project stock or not by using the Valuation category field. If you select Q as the valuation category for a material, it means that the material is relevant for valuated project stock and its value is updated in Financial Accounting. If you leave the valuation category blank for a material, it means that the material is relevant for non-valuated project stock and its value is not updated in Financial Accounting. To generate project stock reservations for a component assigned to a network activity, the following prerequisites must be met:

The network activity must be assigned to a WBS element that is relevant for project stock management.

The material master of the component must have a procurement type that allows project stock management (such as E, F, or X) and an individual/collective requirements indicator that allows individual requirements (such as 2 or 4). The

project definition must have the Project Stock indicator set to either non-valuated or valuated project stock.
