Correct Answer: B

QUESTION 3

Which of these is the only element that is not a vital part of an appointment matrix?

- A. Room availability
- B. Staff availability
- C. Patient billing details
- D. Catch up times

Correct Answer: C

The appointment matrix should display room availability, staff availability (and unavailability, e.g. holiday times) and



should have built-in catch up times to make up for any overruns during the day. A well-run appointment matrix minimizes the chances of patients arriving and no doctor or room being available for them to be seen.

QUESTION 4

Which of these can be reported to relevant authorities without a patient's consent?

- A. HIV status
- B. Illegal narcotics in bloodstream
- C. Gunshot wound
- D. Blood alcohol level

Correct Answer: C

In most circumstances the right of the patient to confidentiality is paramount.

That means his/her consent to confidential information being released must be obtained.

However, in the case of gunshot wounds, information may be passed to law enforcement agencies even if the patient should not wish this to happen.

QUESTION 5

To ensure accuracy in testing all equipment must be properly _____.

- A. Calibrated
- B. Cleaned

Correct Answer: A

However accurate a testing apparatus may be, it will not produce a correct result unless it has been calibrated properly prior to use. Always check apparatus is properly calibrated using manufacturer instructions, and regularly recheck calibration throughout testing.

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
