Recipient expansion

When searching any of the recipient properties (From, To, Cc, Bcc, Participants, and Recipients), Microsoft 365 attempts to expand the identity of each user by looking them up in Microsoft Entra ID. If the user is found in Microsoft Entra ID,

the query is expanded to include the user's email address (or UPN), alias, display name, and LegacyExchangeDN. For example, a query such as participants:ronnie@contoso.com expands to participants:ronnie@contoso.com OR participants:ronnie OR participants:"Ronald Nelson" OR participants:"".
